

## LockDown Browser and Respondus Monitor student guide

### WHAT IS RESPONDUS LOCKDOWN BROWSER?

LockDown Browser is a custom browser that increases the security of online testing in Moodle. Some AUB Moodle online exams will be requiring Lockdown Browser to conduct the exam. As a student, when you start an exam that uses lockdown browser, you will be prompted with a button to start the browser from within Moodle. When you use LockDown Browser to access a quiz, you will be unable to print, copy, go to another URL, access other applications, or close a quiz until it is submitted for grading.

### WHAT IS RESPONDUS MONITOR?

Respondus Monitor is a webcam feature for LockDown Browser that records students during online exams. When this feature is enabled for an exam, students are required to use a webcam and microphone with LockDown Browser. After the exam is complete, an instructor can review details of the recorded videos.

### INSTALLING LOCKDOWN BROWSER

LockDown Browser must be installed to each computer (Windows or Mac) being used to take a test. This is a one time installation.


- Login to Moodle with a regular browser, select the course and navigate to an exam or a practice exam that your instructor has prepared.
- From this screen, you can either install LockDown Browser or launch it to take the quiz.
- If this is their first time using the lockdown browser, **Download LockDown Browser** will enable a you to install LockDown Browser to your computer. You will be directed to download the browser (~70 MB) based on operating system choice Windows or MAC
- If the computer already has LockDown Browser installed, you should simply click **Launch LockDown Browser** to begin the exam in LockDown Browser.

Respondus LockDown Browser with Respondus Monitor (webcam) is required for this exam.


Once the **Respondus LockDown Browser** is installed, you can start using it by clicking on **Launch LockDown Browser** to start the on-boarding process before starting the Moodle exam.

## LAUNCH LOCKDOWN BROWSER

If prompted to close a blocked program (e.g. screen capture, instant messaging), choose Yes.


### STEP 1: TERMS OF USE

Student has to read the terms of use and then click on **Agree** button to proceed




## STEP 2: WEBCAM CHECK

If a student is required to use a webcam to record themselves during a quiz, a Startup Sequence will guide the student through a webcam check and other items required by the instructor.




## STEP 3: ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS

Student has to read additional instructions added by the instructor and click **Continue** button when done




## STEP 4: GUIDELINES + TIPS

Student has to go through a sequence of guidelines and tips for better exam experience. Click on the **Next** button when done




## STEP 5: STUDENT PHOTO

Student has to take a couple of pictures before clicking on **Continue** button




## STEP 6: SHOW ID

Student has to show AUB ID and select **Take picture**



## STEP 7: FACIAL DETECTION CHECK

Student has to position his/her face well in the window and clearly visible during the exam. Once the facial detection is successfully checked then proceed by selecting **Continue** button



After completing successfully the on-boarding process, the student will be directed to Moodle exam to enter the password shared by the instructor to start the exam.

Once an exam has been started with LockDown Browser, the student cannot exit the quiz until the Submit Quiz button is clicked.
